

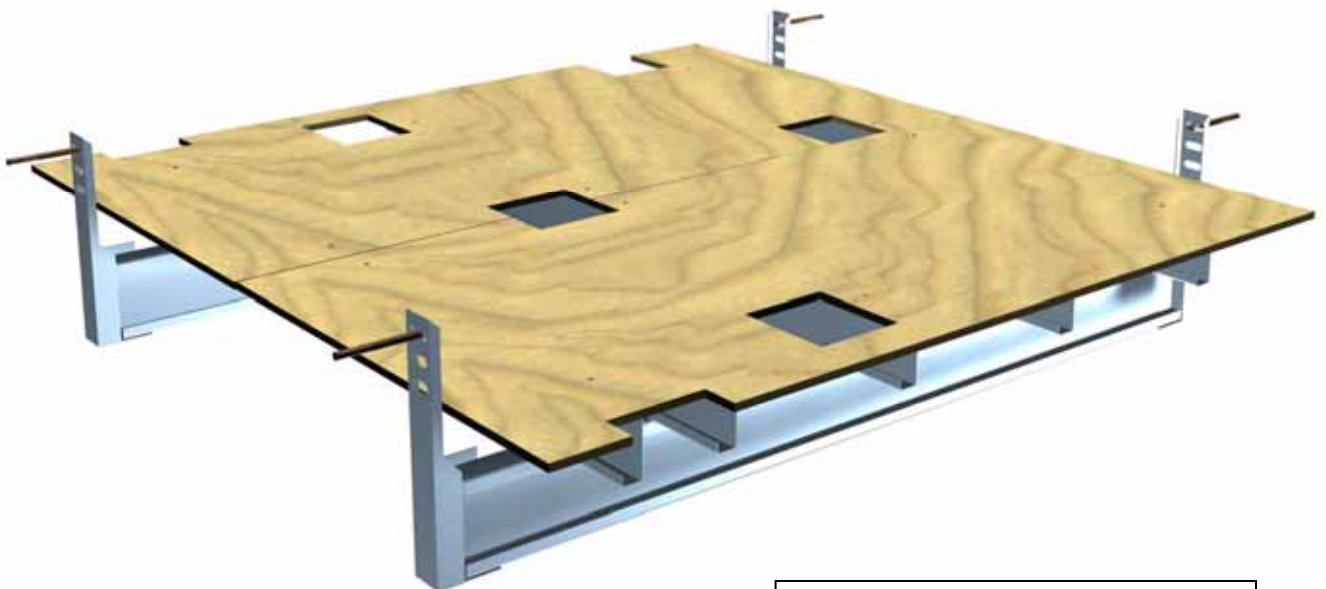

What are Liftdecks?

Liftdecks are temporary working platforms, which are custom designed and installed by a professional team of engineers at Liftdecks UK.

LiftDecks UK have over 40 years of lift installation experience. They can take your GA construction drawing and design a structurally supported platform that exactly meets the needs of the lift engineers on site. Apertures are pre-cut, in the correct locations, to allow ropes, guides and trunking to be easily fitted for hassle free lift installation. The deck remains in place during installation, thus allowing easy and safe access to and from the lift shaft.

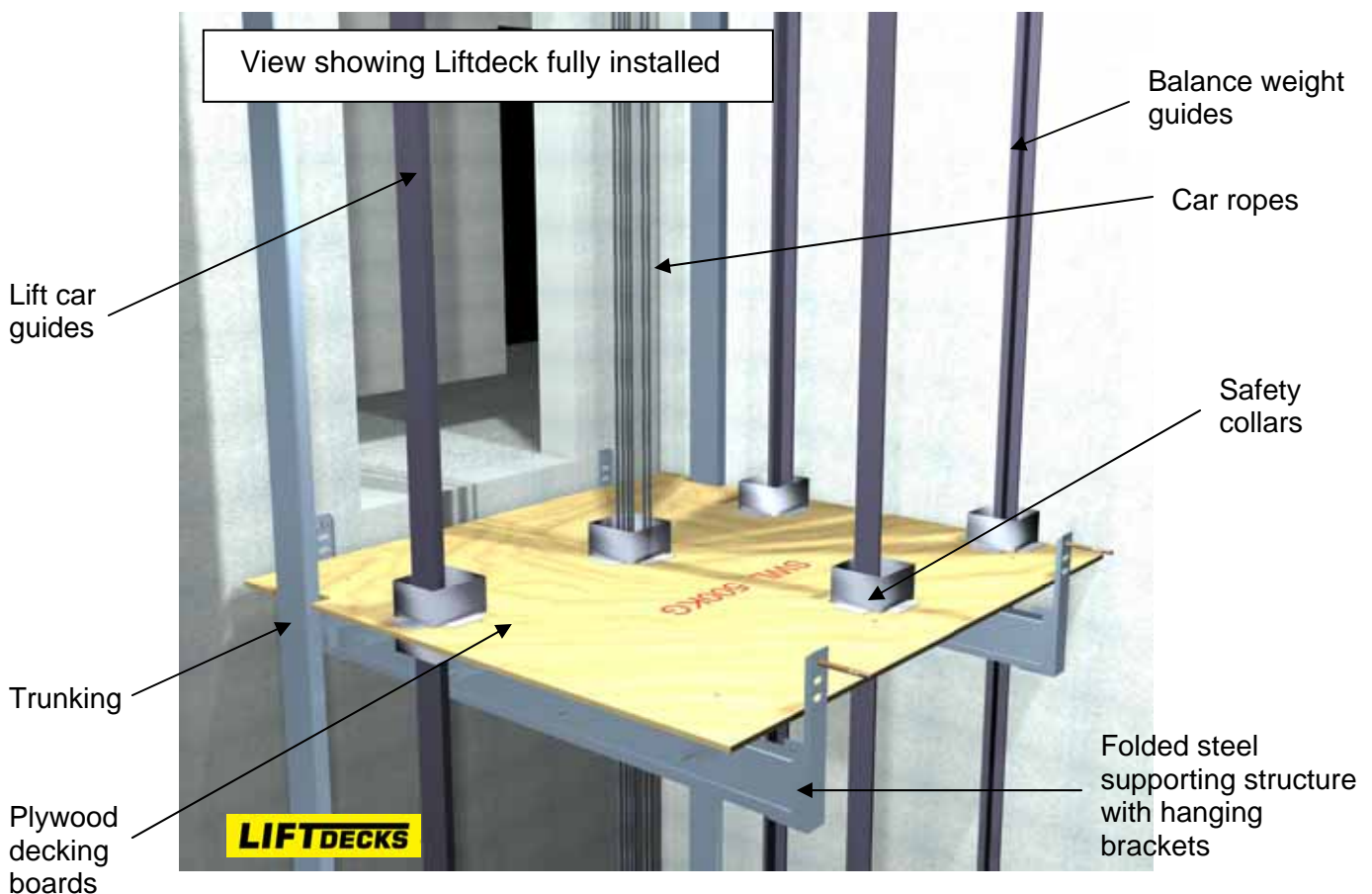
Why choose Liftdecks over scaffold?

Liftdecks are inherently safer than the old scaffold system, they remove the need to overstretch, climb and squeeze through small gaps to work and gain access to the shaft area.

With scaffold, lift engineers frequently have to turn over or remove scaffold boards to allow ropes and guides to pass through during lift installation. This procedure critically increases the chance of falling through openings and stepping on loose or unsecured boards resulting in the majority of lift installation injuries.

The Liftdeck system uses large plywood boards that are cut to bespoke sizes with minimal gaps and apertures which are fitted with high collars to stop objects from falling through. The boards are then fixed to the steel supporting structure to create a stable and flat working platform.

When installed early enough, Liftdecks can be safely used by other trades simultaneously on different levels (dry liners, electricians, painters etc.) without any dangers of falling down the lift shaft. Therefore all 'in shaft' contracting work is optimised for speed, safety and access.

How much do they cost?

Liftdecks can generally be installed at an equivalent invoice price to scaffold, however their safety features and advantage of reducing contractor's site times and access issues means their real **cost** price is much lower to the overall project.

How long do they take to fit?

Liftdecks can be installed as quick if not quicker than traditional scaffold.

Where can they be fitted?

Liftdecks can be installed within virtually all types of shaft or opening constructed from brick, concrete, blockwork or even steel frameworks.

What weight can they hold?

Liftdecks safe working load for the platform is 500KG evenly distributed, although higher ratings can be achieved by design.

Are Liftdecks limited to certain manufacturer's equipment?

No. **Liftdecks** can be adapted to most lift installations, regardless of the manufacturer, and can be adapted to fit most shaft situations.

Liftdecks Main features:

- Many trades can work in the shaft simultaneously
 - Removes issue of only one trade working in shafts at one time
 - Can remove dependant time plans
 - Shaft no longer limited to lift personnel
- Installed usually at similar costs, if not slightly cheaper to scaffold
 - Designed and tailored for each site (no modifications needed)
 - Professionally installed and removed
 - Installed as quickly as traditional scaffolding
- No specialist scaffolders needed for set-up and adjustments
 - Removing dependency of trade and their availability
- Decks can be used by all trades
 - No set-up of scaffold for each trade saving duplicate costs
